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OVERVIEW



We are seeking a Cleanroom Process Operator Technician, ideally with some experience, but are willing to consider candidates at entry level who can demonstrate their enthusiasm to work and succeed in a regulated environment. In these roles the successful candidate will be involved in the day to day running of our aseptic filling and packaging processes. Candidates for these positions must be motivated and driven to succeed.

The ramp up phase will be a challenging and a rewarding time for the successful candidates. The successful candidates will be part of a team responsible for manufacturing, processing and maintenance duties on a fully automated filling and packaging line in a regulated environment. The successful candidates will also have responsibilities for utilities maintenance in conjunction with service providers. The current work pattern for these positions is days on a 37.5hrs per week.

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RESPONSIBILITIES



- Carry out filling / packaging activities and ensure that all activities are performed to cGMP standard.
- General maintenance of the processing line and utilities in conjunction with contract specialist service providers
- Ensure that classified areas and its environment are kept to the highest standards of cleanliness in line with cGMP.
- Support and work proactively with all members of the production business unit in maximizing performance
- Focus on delivering continuous improvement projects to reduce downtime and improve equipment performance
- Implement continuous improvement initiatives
- Maintain and complete all company documentation to the highest cGMP standard accurately and efficiently.
- Ensure compliance with cGMP, Health & Safety, environmental and company standards. Environmental Monitoring of classified areas.
- Audit preparation & Participation
- Perform other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS



Entry level applications are welcome to apply but must be able to demonstrate drive, enthusiasm, ambition and commitment at interview stage.

Applicants for this position must have a minimum of Leaving Certificate Standard with mechanical aptitude / trade, or Science / Engineering qualification and be able to demonstrate a desire to work in science / regulated environment.

The qualifications and experience listed below are representative of the minimum knowledge, skill, and ability required by candidates.

Essential

- 2 years' appropriate experience. Process experience within an aseptic fill environment would be beneficial. In the case of entry level candidates, the experience is not essential, however you must be able to demonstrate a desire to work within a regulated Pharmaceutical / Medical Device clean room environment

- Knowledge or Experience with vision systems and PLC control systems
